- Our current compensation plan is a band, step, and grade system.
- Typically, On your 1-year anniversary an automatic 5% increase and move to the next step in the pay scale will occur, until step 5 is reached.
   As of July 1, 2020 step increases have been frozen.
- Other opportunities for increases include, possible cost of living adjustments (COLAs), which are considered by City Council and / or one-time employee payments.

The new classification plan has been completed with a phased implementation forecast.

### City of Casper Graves Pay Schedule for Sworn Police Employees as of July 1, 2021

This pay structure includes steps for pay increases, which is typical in para-military careers. There is no guarantee for an annual step increase, as it is budget dependent. These base rates do not include overtime compensation.
