limit permitted by State Statute).

December 11, 2019 180-day statutory deadline to complete the annexation.

January 2, 2020 20 <u>business</u> days after the final reading of *Ordinance (Assuming it* 

occurs on December 3, 2019) the annexation becomes effective.

*Note:* There is a 60-day appeal period before the annexation is final.


