To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting,
Certificate No. 87.

Whereas, Charles K. Bucknum, Mayor
of the town of Casper, Natrona County, Wyoming,
in trust for the several use and benefit of occupants
of the townsite of Casper in said County and State
according to their respective interests, has deposited
in the General Land Office of the United States a
Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Douglas
Wyoming, whereby it appears that full payment
has been made by the said Charles K. Bucknum
Mayor, as aforesaid in trust as aforesaid, according
to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April
1872 entitled "An act relating further provision for
the sale of the Public Lands" and the acts supplemental
thereto, including the act of September 30th, 1890, for
the South Half of the North East Quarter and the
North half of the South East Quarter of Section ten
in Township thirty three north of Range seventy nine
west of the sixth Principal Meridian in Wyoming.
Containing one hundred and sixty acres according
to the official Plat of the Survey of said Lands, re-
turned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor
General, which said tract has been purchased
by the said Charles K. Bucknum, Mayor as aforesaid,
in trust as aforesaid.

Now know ye, that the United States of
America in consideration of the premises and in
conformity with the several Acts of Congress, in
such case made and provided. Have given and Grant
unto the said Charles K. Bucknum, Mayor as
aforesaid, in trust as aforesaid, and to his
successors the said tract above described. To have
and to hold, the same, together with all the rights
privileges immunities and appurtenances, of whatsoever
nature thereunto belonging, unto the said Charles K.
Bucknum, Mayor as aforesaid, in trust as aforesaid
and to his successors and assigns in trust as aforesaid.
And there is reserved from the lands hereby granted
a right of way between thereon for ditches or Canals
constructed by the authority of the United States.
In testimony whereof, I Grover Cleveland, President
of the United States of America, have caused these
letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the
General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
